2025-2026 GRADE LEVEL TEAM PARENTS

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Act as liaison between assigned staff group and families to identify needs for the teachers and classrooms
- Communicate wish lists and volunteer opportunities (ie, kleenex for classroom, HAC parent volunteers on Fridays, birthday lunch delivery)
- Planning and execution of grade level events
- Collect for holiday and end of year team gifting

DETAILED INFORMATION

- Parent Square is Carmel's main form of communication, so each of you will be set up with access to send communications to your teams. ****Note:** Only those parents that have opted-in will receive your communication. This will be an ongoing process and parents will be able to opt-in at anytime.
- Please ensure that you have registered as a CMS volunteer, so that you are able to help in the classroom.
- Attached is a spreadsheet of all Team Parents. Please introduce yourself to your Co-Team Parents and think about dividing up duties. For instance, one person may want to send communications, one person may want to collect for gifts, planning class events, etc. If you recruit others, just let me know so I can add them to this group.
- Reach out to the staff members on your assigned team to introduce yourself and discuss how you can support them throughout the year. Some teachers request more than others. Some also want to be more involved in grade level party planning throughout the year, while others prefer that you handle all aspects.
- Send a Parent Square post to introduce yourselves to the team families. When sending posts, I think it's really helpful to use the team's name in the subject line so that parents can search for it and note that it is specific to their child's team.
- Items that you should be responsible for (but not limited to) include:
 - Help teachers with communication, recruiting volunteers, wish lists, etc. as necessary.
 - Grade Level Events - Work with your team to set the date, plan snacks and activities, recruit volunteers, and share details with the classes.
 - Holiday & End of Year Gift for your team - Collect from families for gifting to the staff members on each team. This is usually presented to the staff members before winter break and at the end of the school year. All money collected will be divided equally among the staff members on your team and presented with Thank You cards. Please keep in mind that you will get questions from parents as to whether they donated, so please ensure you are tracking this individually.
- To send a post, simply select "New Post" from the home page and you should now be able to select your team. As an example, if you are the parent for 6th Grade Bulldogs, you would select '6th Grade Bulldogs Support Team'.
- You may also use the Post Add-ons in your post, such as RSVP, files, forms, ask for items, or request volunteers. These options are found on the left hand navigator of the post when you are on your laptop/desktop. From the app, you will select the + sign at the bottom left of your screen. This is a great feature for sign-ups!
